A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 7, BEACHES AND WATERWAYS; ARTICLE II, BEACH REGULATIONS; ADDING SECTION 7-36, USE OF CHARCOAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is necessary to amend the following:

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Section 7-36. Use of Charcoal be added as follows:

Sec. 7-36. Use of Charcoal.

It shall be unlawful and a municipal offense for any person, at any time while on the ocean beach area, to use charcoal or similar material, for any purpose, punishable as provided in this Code.

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective on after passage by the City Council.
