ORDINANCE NO. 2015-13

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES, ADDING SECTION 18-6, PERVIOUS PAVERS REQUIRED IN TOWN CENTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is necessary to amend the following:

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Section 18-6. Pervious Pavers Required in the Town Center Business Area be added as follows:

Sec. 18-6. Pervious pavers required in the Town Center Business Area.

- (1) For purposes of this section, the "Town Center Business Area" shall be considered to be that area of commercial property located in the City of Neptune Beach bordered by Atlantic Boulevard to the North, the Atlantic Ocean to the East, Third Street to the West, and Orange Street to the South.
- (2) Any replacement of existing sidewalks, walkways, driveways, patios, dining areas, or creation of same on dedicated City right-of-way shall be constructed using pervious pavers as set forth in Section 27-238(b).

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective on after passage by the City Council.
